



How to make your own Code Groups visible to others

Once you have created a Code Group, you can share it with other QWeb Users. (Users with Admin status can also make a Code Group available in the public domain.) This User Guide explains how to do this. It is a stand-alone Guide but you may also wish to refer to the accompanying Video, 'How do I make my Code Groups visible to others?'






Sharing a Code Group with other QWeb Users

 To enable other QWeb Users to find, view and copy your Code Group, first go to 'My Code Groups':




2. Select the Code Group you wish you make visible to other QWeb Users (for example Heavy Cigarette Smokers) by clicking on its name in blue. The Code Group Overview is now visible. Next, click on the grey Edit Details link:







3. Then, select the blue Share Settings link:




4. You are then able to edit the Code Group's Share Settings. To share the Code Group with all other QWeb Users, check the box labelled 'Share on QWeb (All users)':







5. Then click on the Save link:



Your Code Group will now be visible in the QWeb Code Library:



It can be found, viewed and copied by other QWeb Users to their Code Group Library.

If you wish to add your Code Group to another QWeb Users Project where they will be able to edit it, you may find the User Guide 'Linking Code Groups to Projects created by other QWeb Users' helpful.

If you wish to share your Code Group with another QWeb User for Review, please refer to the User Guide 'Reviewing someone else's Code Group'.







Making your Code Group Public: A Guide for QWeb Admins

6. If your QWeb Account has Admin status, you can share your Code Group publicly on the Internet at www.gresearch.org, the public-facing QResearch website.

To do this, go to My Code Groups:



7. Select the Code Group you wish you make visible to other QWeb Users, for example Heavy Cigarette Smokers, by clicking on its name in blue. The Code Group Overview is now visible. Next, click on the grey Edit Details link:








8. Then, select the blue Share Settings link:



You are then able to edit the Code Group's Share Settings.


9. To share the Code Group publicly on the QResearch website, check the box labelled 'Share on QResearch (Internet)':








10. Then click on the Save | link:



Your Code Group will now be visible in the QCode Group Library on the QResearch public website at www.qresearch.org:




The Code Group can be found, viewed and copied by other QWeb Users to their Code Group Library. Once copied, its Codes can also be downloaded if required.






11. QWeb Users with Admin permissions can also use the Share Settings area to write Comments about their Code Group; these will be publicly visible in the QCode Group Library on the QResearch website. To do this, write any comments in the 'Publish comments' text box before you click on the
